A Letter from the President



“IT IS NOT WHETHER you get knocked down, it is whether you get up.” This is one of the many pieces of inspirational advice that Vince Lombardi gave so many of throughout his career. Nearly all of us can attest to having been knocked down at some point—some of us more than others, but we have likely tucked away some life lesson for later use, gotten back up and continued on our journey. As tempting as it may be sometimes to just give up, fortunately, for most of us we are just not wired that way. The important lesson here is that you have to get back up and keep on trying.

When you look at the life of a great man and inspirational leader, like Lombardi, it is important to think about the many contributions that he has made, not only to football but to society in general. He touched thousands of lives directly. It was his ability to lead and motivate his teams that resulted in driving them to be a leading force in NFL history. It was under his leadership that the Green Bay Packers won Super Bowls I and II.

The one thing that has become obvious through discussions around the Actors Guild is that while some of “more seasoned” members are aware of who Lombardi is, many of our younger friends were not familiar with Lombardi—what he accomplished, how he led, and in some cases had not made the connection that the coveted Lombardi Trophy given each February was named for him. Initially that was difficult to accept, but then it hit home that many great leaders inspire only with their words and the legacy they leave behind.

We hope by the time you leave the theater this evening that you are not only a little more familiar with the legendary Vince Lombardi, but that you have found some bit of wisdom and inspiration through the telling of his story that will motivate you to get back up when you are knocked down.

It is still early in 2014 and the timing is right to take a look at what you want to do better or differently and set on that path to a more successful life. Perhaps you find that you want to become more involved in the community. 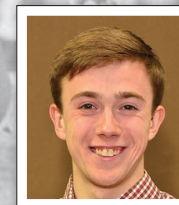
