President's Letter



Eighty days.....hmmmm. Does that sound like a long time or a short time? I guess for our fictional character Phileas T. Fogg and his friends in the late 1800s it was such a short time that it was considered to be a safe bet that a trip around the world in 80 days couldn't even be accomplished. Jules Verne, who wrote the novel on which our play is based, was intrigued at the thought of all the new technological advances of the time and how they would make life easier, and the former impossibilities made possible.

When Rod made the decision to leave this job at the Guild for a tremendous opportunity in New Orleans, he suggested we hire Katie as our interim technical director since she was on summer break before her senior year as a technical theatre major at Saginaw Valley State University. The timing couldn't have been more perfect as the Guild searches for a permanent replacement for Rod.

Welcome, Katie! It's great to have you back, and I have a feeling you will be able to break that 80 day record and accomplish everything here with us in 72 days, just like Nellie Bly!

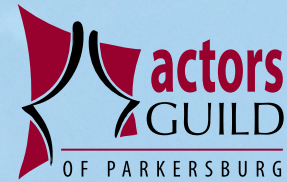
