## Director's Note

**T**HE STRANGE CASE OF DR. JEKYLL AND MR. HYDE by Robert Louis Stevenson was written 2 years before the Whitechapel Murders and Jack the Ripper gripped Victorian London with fear and horror. Little did Stevenson know that his writing would become a part of our everyday language. In fact, the very use of the words "Jekyll and Hyde" today can describe anyone who is vastly different in moral character from one situation to the next. Jekyll and Hyde is one of the most popular works in the world, with over 120 film and stage adaptations alone. Sticking closely to original text of the novella, our presentation is incredibly unique and equally difficult: 4 of our actors portray more than 12 different characters including MULTIPLE Hyde personalities. Playwright Jeffrey Hatcher has adapted this Gothic thriller to be a dark, brooding, mysterious, and thrilling portrayal of split personality. Utilizing a simple set and keeping the transitions between scenes brief, we are able to build the tension of this descent into madness to a mind-twisting climax. Enjoy the show!

## Who's Who in the Cast & Crew

**BEN BRADLEY** (Gabriel Utterson/Hyde) has been actively involved with the Actors Guild for thirteen years. He most recently appeared on the Guild stage in *Spamalot*. His most memorable roles are Lurch in *The Addams Family*, Frog in *A Year With Frog and Toad*, Jesus in *Godspell*, Gaston in *Beauty and the Beast*, and the Cat in the Hat in *Seussical*. He is also actively involved on the building and grounds and the legacy committees. Ben works for Habitat for Humanity as director of the ReStore and has been happily married to his lovely and talented wife, Natalie, for 12 years.

**NATALIE BRADLEY** (Hyde 4/Poole/Surgical Student/Old Woman/Maid) has been involved with the Actors Guild of Parkersburg for a number of years. She has assistant directed *The Secret Garden*, *The Diary of Anne Frank*, *Beauty and the Beast*, and *Seussical the Musical* and has choreographed seven Guild shows, including *Company*. She has also performed in many shows at the Guild, MOVP, and the beloved (and greatly missed) Showboat Becky Thatcher. Natalie is excited to share the stage with her husband once again and would like to thank him for his love and support!

**JOANIE OWEN** (Elizabeth Jelkes/Little Girl) is a Senior at Parkersburg High School, and a proud member of the A Cappella and Chamber choirs. She's on the swim team and was inducted last year into Thespian Troupe #264. She played ensemble roles in both *Spamalot* and *Big Fish*. She also played Olive Ostrovsky in her school's production of *The 25th Annual Putnam County Spelling Bee*. This is her first non-musical play and she hopes you enjoy it as much as she has.

**DAVE PRATHER** (Hyde 3/Sir Danvers Carew/Richard Enfield/O.F. Sanderson/Inspector) is a long-time member of the Guild, appearing in several shows. He received Khalil awards for his performances in *Honk!* (The Cat), *Chicago!* (The Jury), *The Diary of Anne Frank* (Otto Frank), and *The Boys Next Door* (Lucien P. Smith). He has directed several shows, including *A Midsummer Night's Dream*, *Barefoot in the Park*, *Leading Ladies*, and *August, Osage County*. He also garnered a Khalil award for directing *Arsenic and Old Lace*. Dave studied acting at the National Shakespeare Conservatory and writing at Warren Wilson College.

**SHAWN PRICE** (Hyde #2/Dr. Lanyon/Police Doctor/Surgical Student/Drunkard/Hotel Porter) is a theater major. He attended Parkersburg High School where he took part as Vice Principal Douglas Panch in *The 25th Annual Putnam County Spelling Bee*. He has been in the Actors Guild's productions of *Big Fish* as Zacky Price, *Legally Blonde* where he played Nikos Argitakos/Grandmaster Chad, and also in *Monty Python's Spamalot* as Sir Lamerick. Shawn enjoys having a supportive family, mediocre self-esteem, and a rare coin collection.

**J.T. SPIVY** (Dr. Henry Jekyll) appeared in *Company*, as Igor in *Young Frankenstein the Musical*, in *9 to 5 the Musical*, *Shrek the Musical*, as Phil Davis in *White Christmas the Musical*, *Dracula*, *The Full Monty*, *Prelude to a Kiss*, *Alice in Wonderland*, *Beauty and the Beast*, *In the Beginning*, *Ten Little Indians*, and *A Streetcar Named Desire* at the Actors Guild. At Ohio Valley University, he was in *The Importance of Being Earnest*, *Fiddler on the Roof*, *The Merchant of Venice*, and *The Foreigner*.

**BRENTNULL** (Director) returns to the Guild after spending 18 years working, acting and directing in California. He last worked as director here for *Damn Yankees* in 1996. Some of Brent's favorite directing experiences include *The Drowsy Chaperone* (which won an Elly Award for Best Overall Production of a Musical from the Sacramento Area Regional Theatre Alliance in 2010), *Ragtime*, *The Boys Next Door*, *Steel Magnolias*, *Lost in Yonkers*, *A Christmas Story: The Musical*, *My Fair Lady*, *Big River*, *A Chorus Line*, *Oklahoma*, *Pirates of Penzance*, *Fiddler on the Roof*, *Shenandoah*, *Crossing Delancey* and *The Goodbye Girl*.

**MARYLUCAS** (Assistant Director) has appeared on the Guild stage in *Company*, *Young Frankenstein*, and *The Red Velvet Cake War*. She has assistant directed *Big Fish* and *Boeing, Boeing* and was stage manager for *The Mousetrap* and *Barefoot in the Park*. Mary has also worked as production assistant, assistant stage manager, sound operator, and props runner on other shows at the Guild since 2013. Mary has a love of animals and currently has eight indoor cats. She also loves to read, walk half marathons, and travel, and she is learning to play the piano.
