Director's Note

It's hard to believe that it was 18 years ago when the movie of "Elf" first opened and was immediately embraced as an instant holiday classic. Something in the innocence and honesty of Buddy resonated with the world and touched the child in us all.

So, it was no surprise that "Elf, the Movie" then became "Elf, the Musical". After all, "the best way to spread Christmas cheer is singing loud for all to hear." Two relative unknowns were hired to write the score: Matthew Sklar to write the music and Chad Beguelin to write the lyrics. Their only Broadway credit at that time was the musical version of "The Wedding Singer". Since "Elf", they have gone on to write the recent hit musical

"The Prom" which was turned into an even more successful Netflix film. Beguelin also wrote the book and additional lyrics for the stage version of Disney's "Aladdin".

The show first ran on Broadway during the Christmas season of 2010-2011 to sold-out houses. And returned to Broadway again for the holidays in 2012-2013. It has played London's West End, toured extensively around the United States and England to delighted audiences, and made into a stop-motion animated adaptation for television. It definitely has been a hit!

The score of "Elf, the Musical" has one show-stopping song after another. The script has all of the famous lines of Buddy's that have become classic phrases which are repeated by fans of all ages and have become part of our pop culture. I think you are going to love this show! It's bound to put a smile on your face, and as Buddy says "I just like to smile. Smiling's my favorite."

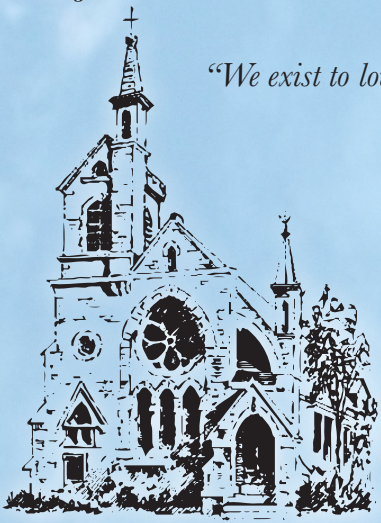

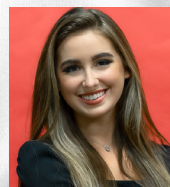

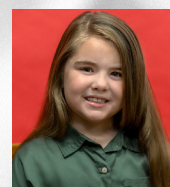
